We offer our students several chances to interact with high school students in Korea, Taiwan, and Deutsche Shule Tokyo Yokohama in Japan. In summer vacation, we visit the Embassy of Botswana and the Embassy of Taiwan, located in Tokyo to figure out the embassy services.









Student Council

The student council consists of a Head Council that oversees everything, including all extracurricular activity clubs and various committees, such as the cleaning and broadcasting committees. The student council is responsible for the daily operation of classrooms and school events.

Shinei SHS's sports festival is held in June. All students are divided into three teams, which compete against each other in many athletic events. September is the

"Asunaro-sai," the school's cultural festival. Many student organizations use this as an opportunity to show off what they have done and to give performances.

The students take pride in this because they have put a lot of time into their organizations. The student council is in charge of planning and operating these crucial events.
